## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

GETSET PLANT GROWTH REGULANT

Plus other REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 582 g/L CHLORMEQUAT as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Target Response	Rate
Poinsettia ornamental (Field and Protected)	To manage height development	1.7 mL product / L water

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply once as a foliar spray during long day phase 2-4 weeks after pinching and when 1-2 cm growth is evident.
- Apply a second application 2 weeks later (up to and including the second week of short days is acceptable).
- Apply a maximum three (3) treatments per crop, with a minimum 2 week interval between consecutive sprays.
- Apply spray in sufficient water volume to achieve thorough and even coverage of foliage.
- Use knapsack sprayer or low-pressure sprayer.
- Addition of non-ionic wetter at 1 mL per litre is recommended.
- Best results are achieved when conditions favour slow drying, allowing better penetration into plant foliage.
- DO NOT apply foliar treatment above 35°C, as chlorosis and phytotoxicity can occur.
- For applications above 30°C, apply overhead irrigation briefly (10 minutes) before application.

### Safety Directions:

Observe the Safety Directions and precautionary statements on the product label. In addition to label requirements: When using the prepared spray and, if applying by spraying equipment carried on the back of the user, wear cotton overalls, over normal clothing, buttoned to the neck and wrist, and elbow-length chemical resistant gloves.

### *Host Safety*

The sensitivity of some varieties/cultivars of poinsettia to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. Foliar spray applications of a chlormequat based plant regulant may result in considerable yellowing around leaf margins or at the tip of leaves. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
