

All-weather Slug and Snail Bait

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

STORAGE

Keep out of reach of children. Store in original container tightly closed and in a locked, dry, cool area away from foodstuffs, domestic animals and poultry. Storage must be in accordance with NZS 8409 Management of Agrichemicals. Stores containing 10,000kg SlugOut are subject to signage and more than 10,000kg require emergency

response plans. PERSONAL PROTECTION

Avoid skin contact. Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after work.

FOUIPMENT

Ensure equipment is clean, well maintained, and accurately calibrated.

DISPOSAL Ensure container is completely empty. Burn empty container in an appropriate incinerator if circumstances such as wind direction permit. Otherwise crush and bury in a suitable landfill. Dispose of product only by using according to the label, or at an appropriate landfill.

Spillage: Sweep up granules and dispose of waste safely (e.g. in a suitable landfill).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the New Zealand (Maximum Residue Limits of Agricultural Compounds) Food Standards.

Broadcast: Use 10-15kg/ha (100-150g/100m²). Use the high rate where slug/snail levels are high. Broadcast evenly over the surface of the ground or band along the plant/drill rows. Apply by hand or through most granule or fertiliser applicators. For small areas use about 6q (1 teaspoon) per square metre. For crop establishment apply baits prior to sowing (1-5 days), at sowing, or immediately after sowing. For emerged or established crops apply immediately damage appears.

Drilling with seed: Drill 10kg/ha into the furrow with the seed. Use only in situations where the drill leaves a distinct open drill slot allowing the slugs easy access to the germinating seeds in the furrow (if in doubt broadcast baits as above). Distribute through granule applicator hopper or mix thoroughly with the seed.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD: Do not apply to edible plant parts. Withhold stock from treated areas for 7 days.
